Photos were taken on the day and an evaluation form was available for the ladies to complete.

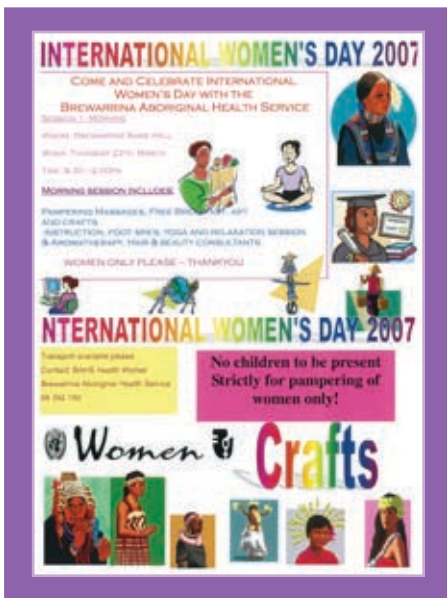
This occasion was extremely well received with positive feedback from the evaluation forms and verbally from participants and community members.
