RVTS offers an alternative GP training pathway to FRACGP/FARGP and FACRRM training for doctors working in AMS MMM2+ locations.

The program specifically targets doctors working in Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Services and rural and remote communities across Australia.

Registrars stay in their community throughout their training and are linked into a nationwide network of medical educators, supervisors, cultural mentors and fellow registrars.
